Electric City Trolley – Friday, June 20 | 7:30 am

The scenic route follows a portion of the former Lackawanna and Wyoming Valley (Laurel Line) Railroad

right-of-way as it parallels Roaring Brook, proceeds past the Historic Iron Furnaces, and continues through the Crown Avenue Tunnel. At 4,747 feet long, it's one of the longest interurban tunnels ever. We will tour the museum and stop on the way home for a late lunch. The cost is \$10/person plus lunch.
